

“Cancer Plus” Health Benefit Plan

Diagnosis of Cancer	Pays \$10,000 up front upon the diagnosis of Cancer (Skin cancer is not covered, although Malignant Melanoma is)
Hospitalization Benefit	Pays \$50.00 a day, beginning the very 1 st day of hospitalization (Very few exceptions)
Receive double benefits if Hospitalized as a result of Cancer or a Heart Attack	Pays \$100.00 a day for the first 30 days, then pays \$50.00 per day for any days beyond 30 days
Daily Convalescence Benefit	Pays \$50.00 per day while recovering <u>at home</u> , upon discharge from a hospital. (To a maximum of 30 days)
Outpatient Cancer Treatment Benefit	Pays \$100.00 a day each and every day you receive a Cancer treatment as an outpatient. (no limit)
Day-Surgery Benefit	Pays \$100.00 if you require day-surgery in a hospital. This benefit is limited to twice per year.
Convalescent Day-Surgery Benefit	Pays \$100.00 a day while recovering <u>at home</u> after Day-Surgery. (To a maximum of 14 days)
Daily Intensive Care Benefit	Pays \$100.00 a day each and every day you are in an ICU unit of a hospital. (Maximum 30 days per stay)
Convalescent Facility Benefit	Pays \$100.00 a day if admitted into a convalescent facility upon discharge from a hospital. (To A maximum of 14 Days)
Daily Outside of Canada Hospital Benefit	Pays \$100.00 a day for the first 30 days, then pays \$50.00 per day for any days beyond 30 days
Home Nursing Care Benefit	Pays \$100.00 a day each and every day a nurse visits your home following a hospital stay. This benefit is payable for one visit per day up to a maximum of 30 visits within 90 days following discharge from the hospital.
